



3 on 3 Rules

- A. 3 on 3 is a half court game played by two teams of three players each. All Possessions must be taken behind the three point arc. At least one foot needs to be behind the three point arc.
- B. **Do not “check” in balls.** Any passed ball is considered live.
- C. Games are ended when a team reaches 15 points. You **do not** need to win by 2. Points are by 1's and 2's, with 2 points being awarded for a would-be three pointer. The first ball possession is determined by a free throw shot-made. After a made basket, a team must pass the ball into play from behind the 3 – point arch. After a change in possession, a team must take the ball behind the 3 – point arch, no pass in is needed.
- D. There are **no timeouts**.
- E. **No “make it – take it”.**
- F. **Fouls:** Players call their own fouls. Offense calls fouls, defense calls violations (traveling, double dribble).
- G. **Substitutions:** Substitutions may be made after a basket or a stoppage of play (injury).
